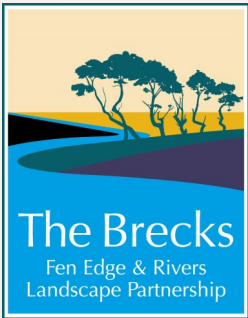


VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!

Thursday 18th March 2021 : 3pm-4.30pm

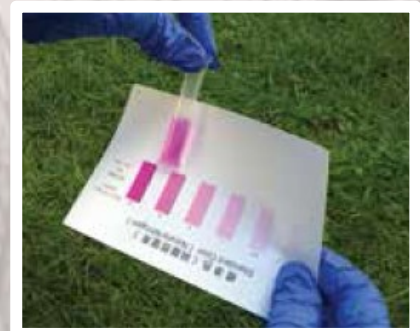
